

HSGI – Battle Belt Size Advise

As tactical gear is sized and worn very differently from normal every day wear clothing it is important that you measure with a tailor tape where and with what you will be wearing the belt. If for instance you may be wearing a regular every day wear belt underneath, a jacket, etc. Any can add bulk.

The Sure Grip Padded Belt itself is about 2" of bulk. Next you must decide if you want a gap, the size of gap you would prefer, none at all or even have the belt overlapping. The smaller the belt, the bigger the gap and farther back on your sides the MOLLE will sit. The larger the belt, the closer it will be or even overlapping, having the MOLLE sitting more towards your hip/stomach area. Depending on your actual measurement it is usually best to choose the Sure Grip size closest to that measurement, unless you are wanting a larger gap.

If you are ordering an inner belt, the Duty Belt size should match the Sure Grip size and any of the Cobra Rigger Belts should be at least one size larger than the Sure Grip size chosen. For example, with a measurement of 42" I would recommend the 41.5" Sure Grip Padded Belt with a Cobra Belt size 40" - 42". This will give between 1"-2" gap. Choosing the 35.5" with a 40" - 42" Cobra belt would have about a 6"-8" gap.

Also, keep in mind that the sizes for the Sure/Slim Grips will be slightly different than the sizes of the Slotted versions of them. The Slotted versions run slightly larger.
